Bridging the Gap Between Theory and Practice in Orthopedics and Trauma Medicine Education

It is an honour to address this conference on a subject that sits at the very heart of healthcare

Education, “Bridging the Gap Between Theory and Practice in Orthopedics and Trauma

Medicine Education.” Orthopedics and Trauma Medicine (OTM) is one of the most practical

and skill-intensive fields in healthcare. Yet, for too long, there has existed a persistent

disconnect between what our students learn in classrooms and what they are expected to

perform in clinical settings.

This gap is not merely an academic concern; it has a direct impact on patient care,

confidence among new graduates, and the overall quality of our healthcare systems.

The Theory-Practice Gap: A Critical Overview

The theory-practice gap can be defined as the disparity between conceptual understanding

and clinical application. In other words, it is where our students know what to do but cannot

effectively do it. This gap is often fuelled by overly theoretical curricula, limited access to

modern clinical facilities, lack of skilled mentors, and assessment systems that prioritize

written exams over practical competence.

Consequences of the Gap

The implications of this disconnect are profound. We see diminished clinical competence, increased medical errors, and a decline in professional confidence. Without bridging this gap, we risk stagnation in innovation and professional growth within Orthopedics and trauma care.

Strategies to Bridge the Gap

To address this challenge, we must pursue a systemic transformation, one that blends academic rigor with clinical reality.

- a) Curriculum Reform: Shift from content-driven to competency-based education. Align theoretical lessons with clinical demonstrations.
- b) Simulation-Based Training: Embrace technology such as orthopedic models, mannequins, and virtual reality to create safe environments for skill practice.
- c) Strengthened Clinical Partnerships: Establish collaborations between institutions and hospitals with clear supervisory roles.
- d) Mentorship and Preceptorship: Assign mentors to nurture learners' confidence and clinical reasoning.
- e) Faculty Development: Equip educators with modern teaching skills and continuous professional development opportunities.
- f) Assessment Reforms: Implement OSCEs, clinical logbooks, and reflective journals that measure competence beyond theory.

g) Research and Innovation: Encourage student participation in clinical research, audits, and case studies.

Case in Point: Mercy Mission Hospital

At Mercy Mission Hospital, weekly case-based seminars were introduced to link classroom theory to real clinical cases. Lecturers and clinicians co-supervised students, improving both skill and confidence through structured clinical rotations.

Conclusion

Bridging the gap between theory and practice is not a simple academic adjustment, it is a moral and professional responsibility. It demands courage to change, collaboration across institutions, and commitment to excellence. Our goal is to produce graduates who are not just knowledgeable but clinically competent, ethically grounded, and confident under pressure.

Mastering Non-Operative Reduction Technique of Bi & Trimalleolar Fractures: A Game- Changer for Resource-Limited Trauma Units

Introduction

Bi- and trimalleolar fractures are traditionally managed surgically with open reduction and internalfixation (ORIF). Yet in many low- and middle-income countries (LMICs), surgeryis not always accessible due to high costs,limited expertise, and operating theatre backlogs. This study presents a structured prospective approach, integrating the Gravity Assisted Reduction of the Ankle (GARA) method Rangan R et al 2022, precise casting with U&L slabs, and a critical 2- week review, to demonstrate safe and reliable outcomes in resource-limited trauma units.

Methods

A prospective case series was conducted at Samburu County Teaching and Referral Hospital between 2023 and 2025. Consecutive patientswith fresh, closed bi- or trimalleolar fractures were treated using the GARA method under sedation, followed by U&L slab immobilization in the supination-adduction position. Radiographic assessments were performed immediately post- reduction and at 2, 6, and 12 weeks. Functional recovery was tracked through staged mobilization and Olerud-Molander Ankle Scores (OMAS).

Results

Eight patients (5 female, 3 males; mean age 43 years) sustained low-energy pronation-external rotation injuries (5 bimalleolar, 3 trimalleolar). All achieved anatomical reduction and maintained alignment throughout follow-up. By 6-7 weeks, patients-initiated weight-bearing, and by 8-10 weeks all had returned to pre-injury activitylevels. OMAS scores at 9-10 months reached 100, with no malunion, instability, chronic pain, or need for secondary surgical intervention. Cost analysis revealed significant savings: ORIF averaged KES 150,000-200,000 out-of-pocket versus KES 2,000-3,000 for structured conservative care.

Conclusion

This prospective case series shows that with biomechanical precision and structured follow-up, non-operative management of bi- and trimalleolar fractures can achieve outcomes comparable to surgery. The GARA method, combined with U&L slab immobilization and a mandatory 2-week review, provides a cost-effective and practical solution for trauma units in LMICs.

Polytraumatic Paediatric emergency care in a remote setup

Introduction

Polytrauma refers to "two or more injuries, one of which may be life threatening, sustained in the same incident that affect multiple body parts or organ systems and results in physical, cognitive, psychological, or psychosocial impairments and functional disability.

Globally, polytrauma forms a significant cause of death and disability. Over 95% of children who die from trauma occur in resource poor settings.

The World Health Organization (WHO) reports that the top five etiologies for unintentional injuries are road traffic accidents (RTAs), falls, burns, drowning and poisoning.

Emergency care depends on recognition of severe injury or illness and timely intervention. It involves the ability to quickly obtain care, rapid and appropriate referrals and the safe transportation of patients.

Approach to Paediatric Resuscitation

•The most critical factor in resuscitation irrespective of available resources is timely recognition and identification of early warning scores that ensures critically ill children are identified and care escalated before cardiac arrest occurs.

Sequence of Emergency

Care

•Pre-hospital care

•Hospital care

•Surgical care

Emergency care protocol

AMEGA protocol

Assess the situation: Identify the nature of the emergency, the potential hazards.

Manage the scene: Secure the area, control access.

Evacuate or rescue: Remove people from danger and provide emergency care.

Get help: Call the emergency services and provide them with the necessary information.

Aftercare: Provide support to those affected by the emergency.

The (C)ABCDE protocol

C - Catastrophic hemorrhage

Check for any high-volume, dangerous blood loss and take immediate action using locally but acceptable resources-clean clothes, belts, rubber bands etc

A - Airway

Assess a patient's neck and upper spine, listen to their breathing and make sure their airway isn't obstructed.

B - Breathing

Check on the breathing rate and oxygen level

C - Circulation

Checked for catastrophic bleeding, broken pelvic or limb bones. Make use of hardboards, sticks and ropes or backs of trees for splinting.

D - Disability

Evaluate consciousness and potential brain or spinal injuries.

E - Exposure

Check for signs of hypothermia or hyperthermia and stabilize the body temperature.

Conclusion

•Training of rapid response teams improves the chances of survival for the polytraumatized child.

•The basics of resuscitation, even in resource-poor settings, must be gotten right; history, examination, ongoing monitoring and appropriate early interventions

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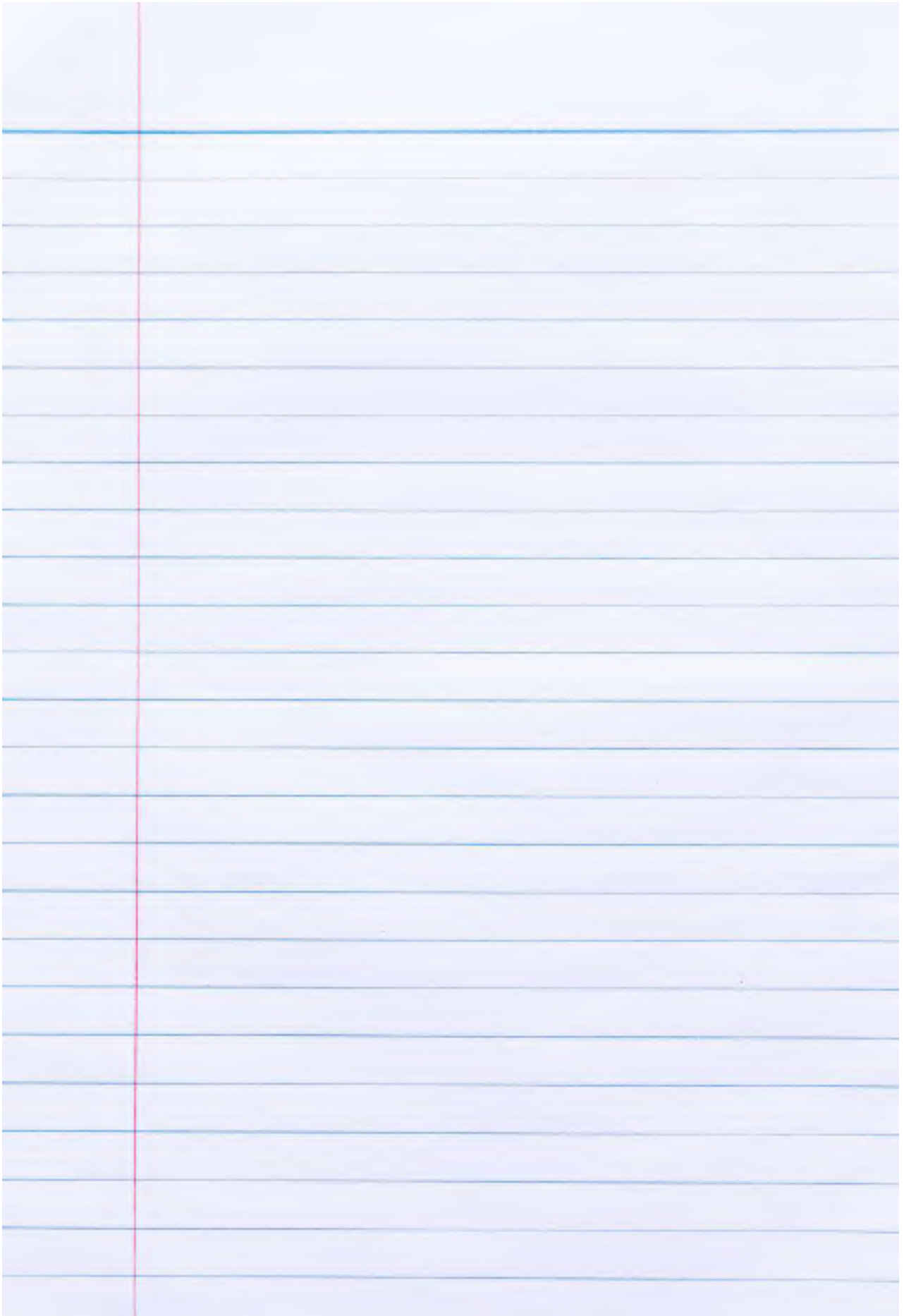


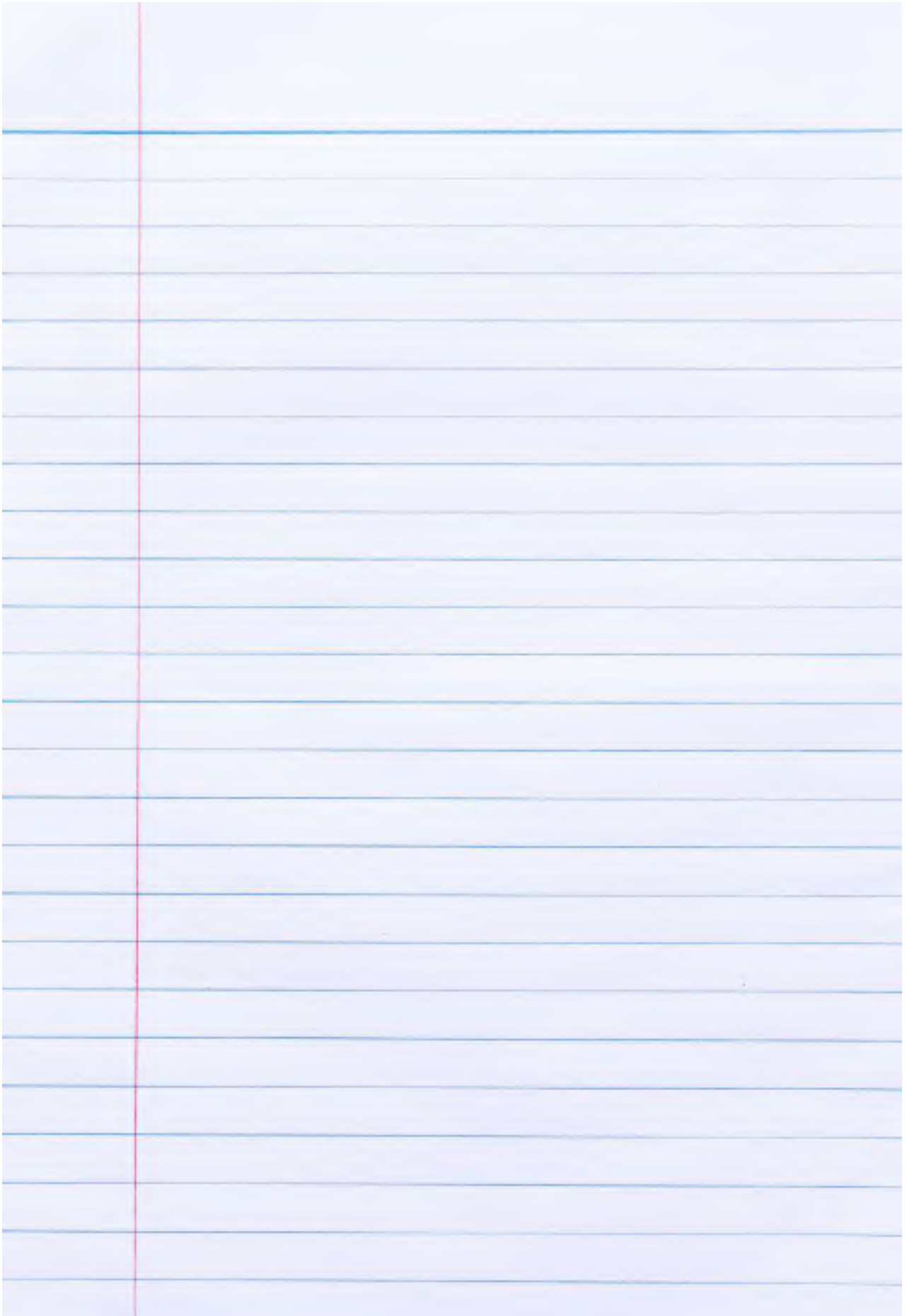

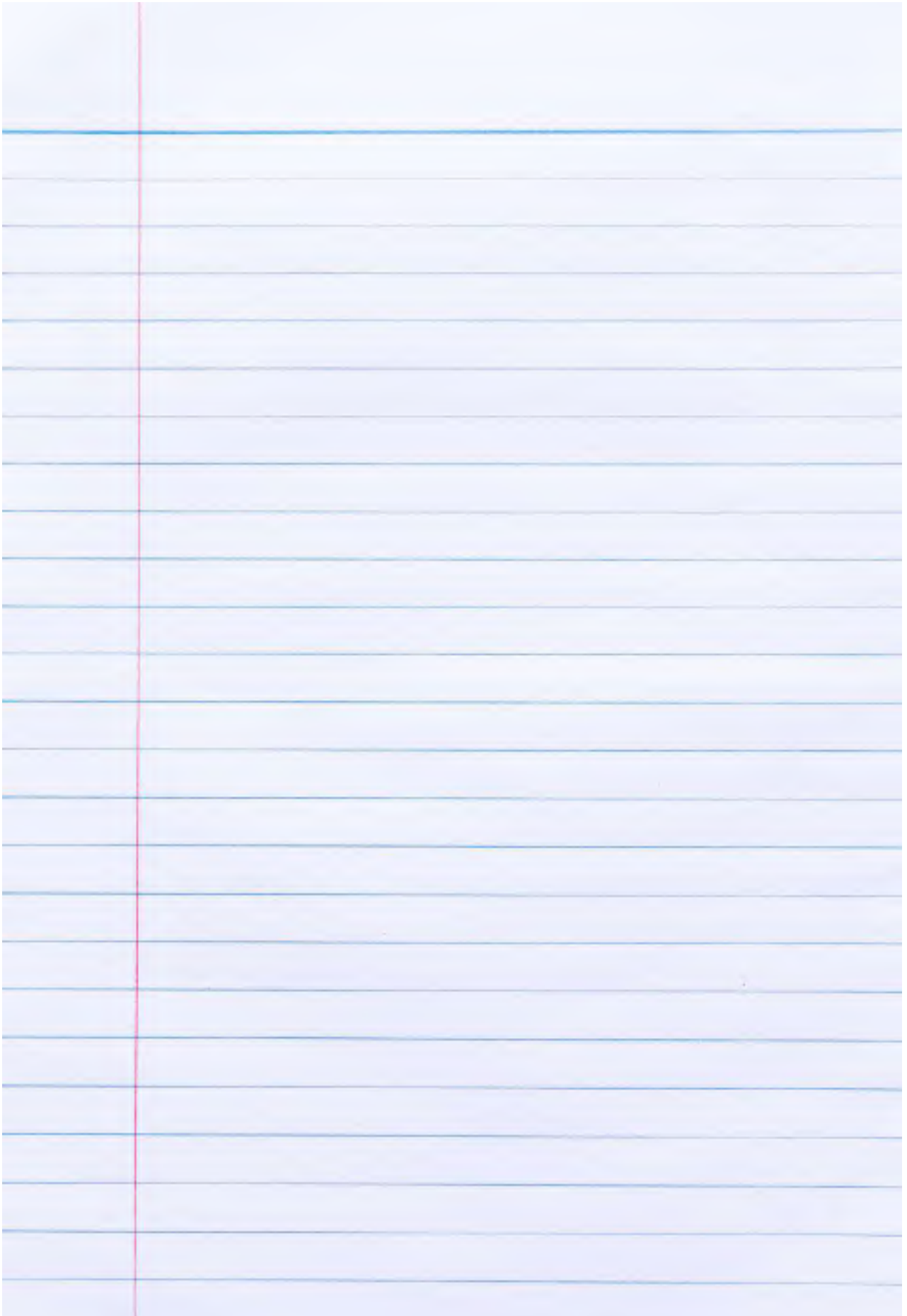
